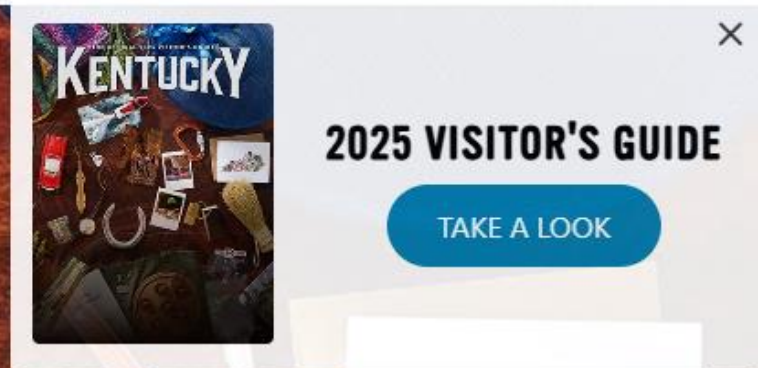

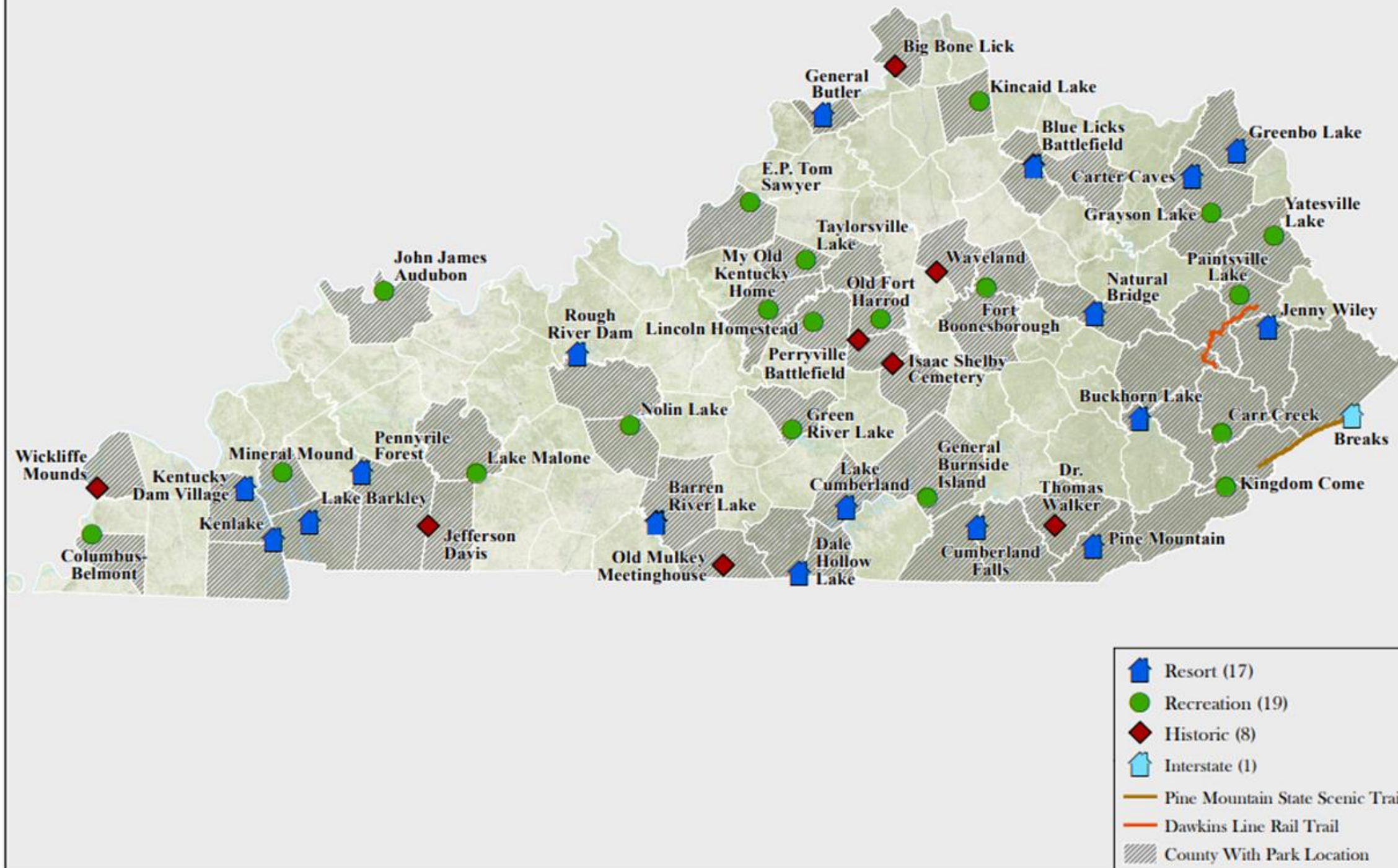


Kentucky State Parks Mission

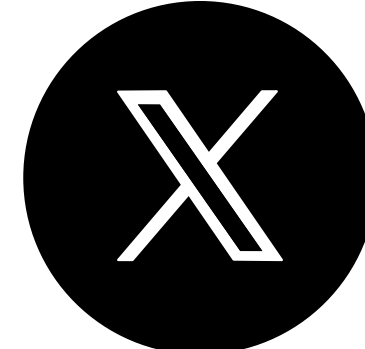

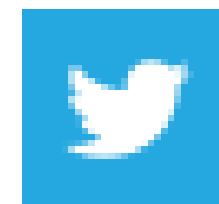
